









Stink was found abandoned and delivered to me, her foster, before her eyes were even open. She was under weight and not expected to survive, but I refused to give up on her. A nursing mother cat who had just lost her two week old kitten, accepted Stink and another unrelated kitten, Marta. Sadly, the cat wasn't able to feed both kittens, so I had to intervene. As a bottle fed kitten that needed to eat every two hours, Stink went everywhere with me. She attended her first event at about ten days old. She became accustomed to being handled and was very friendly and calm in public. Stink became an unofficial ambassador of HART. Due to her popularity with HART supporters, she was adopted without ever being advertised as an adoptable kitten. I called her Stink because, as a tiny kitten, she resembled a baby skunk. Adopting her out was a difficult decision for me, but after meeting the family, I realized Stink would be well loved and cared for. Stink now lives with two dogs and has

made a new best friend with the family's other cat. They enjoy watching bird feeders together. Marta, HART's one time cover model, and Stink's adopted sibling, was adopted by a member of the same family and now has several furry siblings to romp and play with. I miss them both but I know they are living great lives with their new families. I wish them all many happy years together.
